



MTC's main target groups: children with special needs and adults with mental development problems.

ACADEMIC YEAR

The academic year begins in September and is over towards the end of June. It comprises 40 weeks of lectures, seminars and practical work and is mainly divided into 2 semesters. Examination sessions take place at the end of each semester (first session starts in January and second – in June). Students are examined separately in each subject and the total number of examinations in a semester is usually between four and six, but it depends on a study program. Students who fail in an examination, can generally try to pass it again during the session or afterwards.

LIEPAJA UNIVERSITY LIBRARY

The Liepaja University Library is housed in the central building of the University at Lielā iela 14.

The library was founded in 1954; its collection contains 70 000 different items: 66 000 books, about 4 000 periodicals, collection of bachelor and master theses, dissertations, audio-visual and other materials. The library attends to the needs of the students of the Liepaja University, its teaching staff and other personnel. The users can use the lending library, the reading room and the reading room of electronic resources with free access. To borrow books, one needs an ISIC card valid for a year.

Since 1992 the library information system ALISE (Advanced Library Information Service) has been introduced in the library. The electronic catalogue is at users' disposal, and it is easy to use on smartphone and other portable devices (https://alise.liepu.lv). In the electronic catalogue one can find information about the necessary printed materials, book them for work in the reading room or borrow them at the Lending Department, see how many and what printed materials have been taken, when they need to be returned, as well as extend the term of use.

For more diverse search and use of information resources, the library has subscribed databases Letonika, EBSCO, EBSCO eBooks Collection, Cambridge Journals Online, Science Direct, Scopus and Web of Sciences. For registered users databases are available also outside the computer network of Liepaja University.

A bibliographer-consultant will help you in your search for the necessary information. If the necessary printed materials are not held in the library, the user can get any item from other libraries of Latvia, as well as from foreign libraries through Interlibrary Loan Service (SSBA).

During the library's working hours, users can return and hand out printed materials independently using the SelfCheck device. Outside the library's working hours, it is possible to return printed materials using the book-drop box in the university lobby.

The library is equipped with free access computers, with the help of which students can obtain information not only about the library collection and services, but also use them for writing qualification papers, etc. Everybody in need can make use of the paid services in the library - binding the printed materials, copying etc.

INFORMATION FOR OUTGOING ERASMUS+ STUDENTS

Students may apply for the ERASMUS+ program if they:

- Are registered students at Liepaja University
- Have successfully completed their first 2 semesters (except Student Mobility for Placements)
- Speak English or the language of the host country on at least an intermediate level
- Do not have academic or tuition fee debts

Within the framework of Erasmus+ programme Liepaja University offers LiepU **students Study Mobility** (3-12 month) and **Student Mobility for Placements** (2-12 month).

In the beginning of each study semester, students are welcome to apply for exchange studies / internship in Foreign Affairs department by submitting following documents:

- Student Application Form for the Student / Internship Mobility
- Transcript of Record issued by the faculty
- Statement on Academic Success issued by the faculty
- Motivation Letter in English or in the language the studies will be held

THE FOLK DANCE COLLECTIVE "BANGA" and "BANDZENIEKI"



SCHOLARSHIPS

Latvian Scholarships for studies in Latvian Higher Education Institution: in accordance with bilateral agreements on co-operation in education and science, the State Education Development Agency (Valsts izglītības attīstības aģentūra — VIAA) offers scholarships to students of several countries for studies in Latvian higher education institutions (HEIs). The amount of the Latvian scholarship is ~500EUR per month

ERASMUS+ Program Scholarships for studies of internship abroad (500 – 700 EUR per month).

ARRIVING IN LIEPAJA

Latvia is one of the European Union's (EU) member states and, if you are an EU citizen and want to relax, you can go to Liepāja with only your passport or ID card. Citizens from other countries outside the EU may have a slightly more complicated entry.

Before considering to come to study in Latvia and to apply for the residence permit and then for visa, check all the requirements and documents necessary to submit to the embassy of the Republic of Latvia or to send to the University.

Liepaja is located 220 km west from Riga, 100 km north from Klaipeda, a city in Lithuania, on the coast of the Baltic Sea. You can get to Liepaja by plane, train or bus from Riga and by bus from Klaipeda or Palanga. Normally a bus ride from Riga to Liepaja takes about 3 hours 30 minutes and a bit less than 2 hours from Klaipeda. You can get to Liepaja by your own car from Riga even faster than by public transport.

BY PLANE

It is possible to travel from Riga to Liepaja's airport by plane (AirBaltic) several times a week in 30 minutes and the ticket costs from about 15 EUR to 40 EUR. Palanga (Lithuania) airport is just about 65 km south; it has direct routes all year round. Riga International airport, the largest airport in the Baltic States, offers many direct flights to Europe and Asia, including AirBaltic, Ryanair and Wizz Air routes.

BYCAR

There are two main roads going to Liepaja. One is A9 from Riga direction, and the other is A11, from Klaipeda. Other roads are P111 to/from Ventspils. and many regional roads.

BY BUS

Liepaja is connected by bus service with Riga (multiple times every day), Klaipeda, Palanga, Ventspils, Kuldiga and other towns, as well as smaller villages in Liepaja region. The Bus station is located some distance away from the center. Take the tram to the south to get to the center (take the tram at a tram stop, which is on your right side when you quit the Bus station building. Do not cross the tram-railway, which is a wrong direction! The Liepaja regional bus terminal is located in the southern part of the center, at Sienatirgus. But all busses go to the main Bus station. A ticket to Riga costs around 9 EUR. Liepāja's bus company offers you the possibility to get from Liepāja to the airport "Rīga" and also in the opposite direction from the airport "Rīga" to Liepāja without entering the centre of Rīga by using the bus route Liepāja-Rīga-Liepāja. To get from Liepāja to the airport "Rīga" to Liepāja, on the day of travel reserve your seat.

BYTRAIN

A nice and relatively quick train runs to and from Riga. It leaves the Liepaja railway station (which is the same building as the bus station) and arrives at Riga railway station. These trains also stop at Skrunda, Saldus, Dobele and Jelgava. Despite the fact that the train actually takes a longer route — about 240 km compared to 220 km if you go by bus — because it goes through Jelgava, it takes a bit less time to go to Riga by train than by bus. A single one-way normal fare ticket costs around 9 FUR.









LIEPAJA

Liepaia is a city of successful changes as the people living here on the stretch of sand between the Amber Sea and the lake for more than 750 years have always been tough, wise and daring. The charm of the city is concealed in its special atmosphere. Perhaps a bit restrained and harsh, yet also noble and rebellious. Sometimes calm, sometimes swirling. Genuine and truthful – this is Liepaja. Liepaja has grown from a small village into the third largest city in Latvia with the population of 76 513 people. Liepaja is a great city for students because it's rich in wellestablished cultural traditions. Liepaja is the home of the oldest professional Latvian theater, the only professional symphony orchestra outside Riga, a puppet theater, a number of folklore groups and numerous choirs. Organ music as well as jazz holds an important place in the cultural life of the city. The Summer Sound and Fontaine Festival have become the central pop and rock festivals in the city.

Liepāja is a capital of music. Seems only natural that it now also has its own concert hall "Great Amber". At the basis of the architectural concept of the concert hall, created by the excellent Austrian architect Prof. Volker Giencke, lies amber – the symbol of Liepāja and the Baltic Sea, as well as the concert hall's function as a cultural and arts centre.

After the construction of the Olympic Center, Athletic Arena, Indoors Tennis hall Liepaja has become a popular place for national and international sports events.

Liepaja is surrounded by water. There is the Baltic Sea coast, two big lakes and some smaller ones as well as there are four channels in the city. Liepaja Lake is the fifth largest lake in Latvia. Liepaja beach is a great place to relax. Those who want to get the first tan, show up in the beach as soon as the snow is gone and the sun gets warmer. However, unforgettable sunsets in the sea can be enjoyed throughout the year.

Liepaja is a port city. For passengers there are a one line Liepaja-Travemünde, Germany, but those traveling with a yacht can moor it in the Trade Channel almost in the downtown





GETTING AROUND

There are four types of public transport in Liepaja city – tram, bus, taxi and minibus. There you can download all timetables of Liepaja Public transport: http://www.liepajastransports.lv/en.

TRAM has only one line. It runs from the Southeastern part of the city (Ezerkrasts), along beaches, through the center, to Jaunliepaja, a place with a flea market and ends near the metallurgic factory. It operates from 5AM till midnight and costs 0.70 EUR if ticket is bought in a boutique, or 0.80 EUR if you buy it from the tram driver. Ticket must be validated in one of three yellow validators in the tram, which will print date and time on the ticket. The ticket is valid for one ride. Tram is the best transport to get to/from the Railway/Bus station to/from the city center. If you are going to catch the morning train to Riga, do so, because trams operate in early morning, but not as frequently. A ride from the center to the station takes approximately 8 minutes.

BUS has many lines, the most important are 1,3,4,7,8 – with these you can get from the city center to Karosta and back. You can get to the Southeastern part (Ezerkrasts) to see Meynard's church and Liepaja Lake by 3, 4, 10, 15, 912. Buses stop at bus stops throughout the city. Tickets can be bought in boutiques (0.70 EUR) or from the driver (0.80 EUR). Tickets must be validated in the bus by inserting them in an electronic validator just like in trams. All buses have audio announcement system for next stop and a LED screen in front of the bus displaying the next stop name. In case of going to Karosta you will most likely want to go till the last stop, so don't worry. An exception is bus number 8, which goes far north in summer house and garden district Skede near the sea, which is kind of too far for Karosta, however is the best bus to get as far as the Jewish holocaust memorial or the Northern fortress.

TAXI is relatively expensive compared to other types of transport, but still cheaper than in Western Europe. This is, however, the only public transport available in the night (approximately from 12:30AM-5AM). There are some places in the city center and near the Bus/Railway station where Taxi cars use to assemble, but you can call (+371) 63422222, (+371) 63488888 or 8500 (free Wi-Fi)

MINIBUS has two lines – 22 and 23, with which you can get from Karosta to the city center, Peter's market (Petertirgus) and back. They both depart from 5:00AM-6:00AM till almost midnight. The ticket costs the same as tram and bus – 0.70 EUR if bought in boutiques and 0.80 EUR if bought from the driver. The same as buses, minibuses also have audio announcement system for next stop and LED screen in front of the bus displaying the route.

The 22nd minibus runs along the Olympic Center, but 23rd runs through the North suburb (Laumas rajons).

SIGHTSEEING

You'll need at least a couple of days to see everything that Liepaja has to offer. Spend the night in a haunted prison, climb up to the clock tower of Holy Trinity Church for spectacular views of the city, soak up the atmosphere at Peter's Market, explore the ruins of a tsarist fort or just spend time at the Blue Flag beach.

ROSE SQUARE H

The square housed a new market from 18th century, later market was moved away and place got a look of a green spot. The first roses were planted here in 1910, in recent times monument was created, depicting names of the sister cities of Liepaja and their symbols
